DISCIPLINARY POLICY

If the behaviour of any young player within the mini/junior section (any player under the age of 18) contravenes the players code of conduct while representing the club disciplinary action will be taken.

This includes behaviour:-

- On the clubs premises
- Before or after designated training times or at training/games
- On and off the field
- Home or/and Away games
- Damage to club property

The procedure to be adopted is as follows:-

The alleged incident should be reported to the club welfare officer who will notify a designated person on the committee.

The young player will be notified to attend a meeting with a parent/guardian or his/her coach.

The young player can be suspended from the club till the outcome of the investigation.

Witnesses may be called to give statements if required.

When a conclusion has been made the player and his/her parent will be invited to attend a meeting to hear the outcome.

All meetings will be documented and an incident form will be completed.

The club has the right to revoke any membership if deemed necessary.
